

BY-LAW NUMBER 2013-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to acquire Part of Lot 5, Concession 13, Township of Innisfil, as in RO854266, except RO948780 & RO1000656, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe from Simcoe County Christian Senior Home Inc. and to establish same as part of the municipal highway system.

WHEREAS Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the "Act"), provides that a single tier Municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein, including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie adopted Motion 05-G-338;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to acquire Part of Lot 5, Concession 13, Township of Innisfil, as in RO854266, except RO948780 & RO1000656, Barrie, County of Simcoe for road widening purposes;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to acquire Part of Lot 5, Concession 13, Township of Innisfil, as in RO854266, except RO948780 & RO1000656, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe and to establish same as part of the municipal highway system.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts the following:

- 1. **THAT** The Corporation of the City of Barrie acquire Part of Lot 5, Concession 13, Township of Innisfil, as in RO854266, except RO948780 & RO1000656, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe.
- 2. **THAT** Part of Lot 5, Concession 13, Township of Innisfil, as in RO854266, except RO948780 & RO1000656, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe be established as part of the municipal highway system and be named Patterson Road.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 2nd day of December, 2013.

READ a third time and finally passed this 2nd day of December, 2013.
