as

International Day of Persons with Disabilities

WHEREAS; The annual observance of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities was

proclaimed in 1992 by the United Nations General Assembly; and

WHEREAS; We recognize the strides persons with disabilities have made in every aspect of political,

social, economic and cultural life, and work to raise awareness of the struggles yet to be overcome. The annual observance of the Day is an opportunity for the City of Barrie to make a renewed commitment to the principles of dignity and justice for all, in support of the implementation of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities; and

WHEREAS; The City of Barrie Council adopts each year the City's Accessibility Plan under the

Ontarians with Disabilities Act and the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act;

and

WHEREAS: The City's Accessibility Advisory Committee advises on the development of this plan.

which works to support the UN's 2020 theme for International Day of Persons with Disabilities: 'Not all Disabilities are Visible' which focuses on spreading awareness and understanding of disabilities that are not immediately apparent, such as mental illness, chronic pain or fatigue, sight or hearing impairments, diabetes, brain injuries, neurological disorders, learning differences and cognitive dysfunctions, among others.
