The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council with an update concerning motion 20-G-246 related to the 400-Cup Pond Hockey Tournament.

Motion 20-G-246 directed staff in the Recreation and Culture Department to work with the 400-Cup Organization on the feasibility of Barrie hosting a pond hockey tournament in 2022.

The 400-Cup Organization focuses on the fun of sport and the experience of special events and tournaments. Over the COVID-19 pandemic, they have offered skill development camps and plan to provide tournaments and special events with a focus on community involvement.

Recreation and Culture Services staff met with the 400-Cup Organization on several occasions to discuss the feasibility and considerations related to the required infrastructure such as water, lighting, parking, storage, location and security of the ice rinks for the event.

After consideration, the 400-Cup Organization has identified the Barrie Community Sports Complex (BCSC) as the location for the event as it offers the required infrastructure needed to plan and host the event. The anticipated event dates are as follows:
