Please circulate this letter to council and to the public.

I am requesting a bylaw change to address the problem of on street parking. I have checked with 29 cities and 20 have controls in place to control it. The controls are from 3 hour maximum to 24 hours. There are some permits available to allow for visitors and extra cars for occasions. I agree with permits to allow for extra cars on street for limited time periods. The 3 hour limit may be tough for some people but the majority of cities have it as a bylaw and it can be used to stop a person from parking their car for days/weeks . A person in Barrie can keep a car on the street for 8 months straight and only need to move it for 4 winter months and only 12 pm until 8 am.They do not need to be on the street for days if they are not being used. The owners can find a storage yard to look after their car or sell it. The cars on the street also pose a threat to people riding bikes when cars are parked on both sides of the street and they need to go around them. This parking problem needs control as it gets worse everyday. People have too many cars and the streets gets the problem.
