- 3. That prior to final approval, the owner shall enter into a legal agreement with the Ministry of Transportation whereby the owner agrees to assume financial responsibility for the construction of highway improvements, if required to accommodate development, and in accordance with the approved TIS.

Please include the following under Notes to Draft Approval:

1. MTO Building & Land Use permits are required prior to site grading / servicing / construction of the subdivision, and for all lots within 800m of Highway 400 ROW limits.
