EMERGENCY DEPUTATION - MAY 31st, 2021

RE: 11 INNISFIL ST, BARRIE, ON

The Council Members of the Corporation of the City of Barrie, The CMHA, the SMDHU, Dr. Simon and Dr. Grdisa have all violated the principles of Procedural Fairness and Natural Justice by failing to notify both tax paying businesses and tax paying residents of their intent to install a Safe Consumption Site (SCS) at 11 Innisfil St, Barrie.

By their own their own admission, their studies and who they notified were for 80 Bradford St. They failed to contact anyone by the actual physical location at 11 Innisfil St and it renders their study useless. Not even a sign was posted to notify local residents and businesses of their intent. Since you could not do door to door Dr Simon, then a bare minimum of Due Diligence you should have been required to post a notice similar to those required for a variance.

It is only because one of my neighbours recognized the location, the picture of the door, that the TRUTH was finally admitted to and disclosed by the City and Co-Applicants.

This Council LITERALLY FAILED to notify their tax paying constituents who entrusted them with the authority to better their community so they could have safe and reasonable enjoyment of their properties and businesses. **The SMDHU, the CMHA and this Council's actions imply an intent to deceive, having misinformed the public with the actual proposed location**. Not only that, it is clear that No One, including Dr Simon and the SMDHU preformed their Due Diligence as evident on May 25th by their lack of knowledge of a fully accredited daycare in direct proximity to this proposed site. Let's not forget that when HIP developments completes their construction, the YMCA will be moving in, and I believe will have a daycare in the building and within proximity to this SCS.

It is concerning that those of you entrusted with the authority to make these decisions appear to be taking advantage of both Covid and the State of Emergency lockdown we are under to push this agenda through.

I have owned in this for over 30 years. Many of my neighbours have been here even longer than that. We remember this area and Milligan's Pond as a beautiful public park that we could bring our kids to or walk our dogs. In more recent years the park has declined so that safety is now a concern when entering. In more recent months, general safety of the area has become alarming. Just last week every member of this council was notified by me about strangers ignoring our fencing and trespassing into our yard at all hours. Property is being broken into. At 3:30 in the afternoon one afternoon, we had to call the police because a man was passed out on the edge of our property, a picture of which you all received. 4 days ago, I found someone's stolen property on my lawn and handed it into the police. The issues are ongoing.

This proposed consumption site is LITERALLY across the street from Milligan's Pond. Introduce this site to this location and not only will you make the issues we already experience WORSE as they have become around the David Busby Center, BUT as a REALTOR, I am certain you will DESTROY the property values of this area affecting many families and their life savings. You will also damage the investment potential of HIP Developments.

It is clear that the Downtown Barrie Business Association(BIA), who paid \$30,000 to a private consultant, wants the addicts out of the core because it affects business in downtown Barrie. I get it, I own property there too. While I understand and empathize with their plight, pushing them into residential communities, along with the drug dealers that will follow them, is not the answer.

I believe in giving a Hand Up, NOT a hand out. If you want to help these people, then help those who want and are willing to invest the commitment to getting better. Give these people a Hand Up. Provide them with counseling, housing whatever it takes. If they are willing to put in the effort, then invest my tax money into them. But invest it by helping them, not by enabling them. Enabling them helps no one. Think about it...do we give an alcoholic a drink? Every recovering alcoholic I know says Absolutely Not! Give them the resources to recover not the resources to get high. It's common sense.

The City of Barrie owns plenty of locations throughout the city, including many empty units at the Barrie Bus Terminal. There is absolutely no reason for the CoB or province to spend yet more tax payer money on rent to provide a SCS. For goodness sake, use the property you already own. Not only would the Barrie Bus Terminal be more cost effective, as the Landlord it will give the City more control over the SCS. Most importantly it is where the target client's are located which apparently is a major criteria for Dr. Simon and the SMDHU

I find it really disturbing that Councilor Morales Is the Chairman of the BIA. As I understand it you Must be a business owner in the downtown core to hold that position. Is Mr. Morales spearheading the campaign to push drug dependent people from the core, as recommended by the BIA's private consultant for his interest in his own business, his interest in the position he holds as Chairman or is it for his interests in both? Let's be clear, any participation in this vote by Mr. Morales would be a conflict of interest.

I would also like to take a moment to reflect on at least one of the livelihoods of a taxpaying citizen you would literally Destroy. The status as a Wee Watch private home child care provider would be revoked by Wee Watch if this Site was installed directly across the street from this daycare. Wee Watch will not permit any location directly across the street from a SCS. This family would loose their livelihood. Destroying their income would in FACT make it impossible to support themselves and pay their taxes. They would have no choice but to sell, and likely at a reduced value, and the current state of the Real Estate Market, they may never be able to find another home that they could afford to purchase, thus reducing their net profit, and quality of life.

On May 25th, this council arbitrarily dismissed the legitimate concern about placing a SCS directly across of the Daycare that I just mentioned. When asked directly, Dr Simon was unable to provide information on the impact that the other 16 SCSs already created in Ontario have had on their areas. This is another substantial failure of Due Diligence.

In fact, did Dr Simon and the SMDHU even bother to conduct an impact study on how the introduction of this SCS to this neighbourhood will affect either Property Values or Businesses and whether they will be able to keep their clientele or have their retirement savings destroyed? Good bye Equity when applying for a CHIP mortgage

NOT ONE of the people who wrote a letter in support of this Site either have a home or a business in this neighbourhood. NOT one of them have an interest in this neighbourhood and therefore have absolutely nothing to lose. Their opinions SHOULD NOT have any bearing at all in this decision, but those whose lives you are going to damage and/or destroy should be heard! We with a direct interest in this neighbourhood are the only Opinions that mater. To be clear Councilor Aylwin, I know of no one, myself included, who support this safe injection site. Last week you misquoted your constituent and we are NOT impressed!

What type of reputation does the City of Barrie want to promote to the Developers and Businesses they are trying attract and encourage to come to this City. Developers and Businesses that will bring both housing and jobs. My understanding is that HIP Developments has made it clear they do not want ANY SCS near their development. Are the Councilor's and the City of Barrie really going to Act in Bad Faith and place a SCS exactly where HIP Developments doesn't want it? Do you really want to damage this relationship with such an important Developer and in turn damage Our Cities reputation in how we do business?

It would be both unethical and immoral if you do not vote against this location. Honestly, if you do not vote against this location, you will be responsible for affecting and/or destroying the lives of productive, contributing members of society, your very tax paying constituents. The result possibly could make them the CMHAs next clients. Dr. Simon and Dr. Gardner should know better. They swore an oath to do no harm. If your excuse to doing the wrong thing is We had to do something, then you should never have been in a position of authority.
