City Extends Patio Hours as Part of Reopening Plan

(Barrie, ON) A special City Council Meeting was held tonight (June 10), where council voted to extend patio hours in recognition of the Step 1 restrictions allowing only outdoor dining, with all other regulations continuing to apply with the operation of the patio.

These hours come into effect on Friday June 11, 2021, as Step 1 of the Provincial reopening framework allows for the opening of outdoor dining with a maximum of 4 people per table.

The hours that a person can enter or re-enter an outdoor area are extended:

- from 10:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. Monday – Thursday
- from 10:30 p.m. to 1:45 a.m. Friday, Saturday, and July 1 Canada Day

The hours that a person be permitted to remain in the outdoor area extended:

- from 11:15 p.m. to 12:15 a.m. Monday-Thursday
- from 11:15 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. Friday, Saturday and July 1 Canada Day

This will be in effect until indoor dining is permitted under the COVID-19 [Reopening Framework](#) as established by the Province.
